website offers...

- What exactly is
 GreenFinder? It is a website
 where people can find
 information on a wide range
 of green products, services
 and organisations. We also
 have articles and news
 stories to make it a bit more
 interesting for people when
 they visit the site.
- How does it work? If people want join a local, organic box scheme to buy their vegetables or would prefer to use organic paint when they are decorating they can use our listings to find exactly what they are



looking for.

- What gave you the idea?
 We were eating out in a restaurant that served local food and I made the comment that there should be a directory which listed all the places that served local food.
- What sort of response have you had? I have had a very positive response and I've had many requests to publicise campaigns and various.
- What's the strangest thing that has been asked for? We have a section on the site called 'My Alter-eco' which features bizarre and odd items. Our first article was about recycled paper made from sheep poo!
- What sort of people use the site? Many people who are just starting to take an interest in green living find

the site useful but also people who have been living sustainably for a while also enjoy browsing the site.

- What started your interest in going green? I have been brought up to recycle and not be wasteful and became more active in environmental issues whilst at college. It's just routine for me now.
- Have you plans to expand the site? We are thinking of having a separate business portal so that companies can access information and advice on how to make the workplaces as sustainable as possible.
- What sort of difference do you think something like this can make? I passionately believe that a green lifestyle should be accessible to everyone. I'm hoping that by encouraging people to make a few small changes in their everyday life that collectively it can make a difference to the environment. Raising awareness is so important.
- What should other people be doing? The key to a green lifestyle is cutting consumption. Buying local food, switching appliances off when not in use, opting for second-hand goods and refusing to buy over packaged goods all help the cause.
